

ISRAEL VOTES 2019

Election analyst JAMES MARLOW compiles this week's poll numbers based on several Israeli leading pollsters.

In total, 47 parties have registered to run and at least one has dropped out since. Only the parties expected to cross the 3.25% minimum threshold are listed below. If a party receives less than the minimum 4 seats, the votes are discarded. The election for the twenty-first Knesset is Tuesday 9 April.
