

# ISRAEL VOTES 2019

Election analyst JAMES MARLOW has put together the final set of poll numbers before the general election based on the leading Israeli pollsters: Midgam Panel, Statnet Institutes, TNS Teleseker, Panels Politics, Direct Polls, Camille Fuchs, Maagar Mohot, Rafi Smith Research, Dr Mina Tzemach and Mano Gever.

47 parties registered to run but several have now dropped out. Only the parties expected to cross the 3.25% minimum threshold which is equivalent to 4 seats are listed below.

Voters were asked who is most suited to become the next Prime Minister:  
38% said Binyamin Netanyahu and 36% said Benny Gantz

Asked who do you think will become Prime Minister:  
56% said Binyamin Netanyahu whilst 22% said Benny Gantz
